

Steps, SOP & Guidelines for Candidates during Skill Test

The steps for “physical verification, original document verification and skill test” will be as follows:

Step-1: Collection of basic information of the candidate

The candidate will fill a form having his/her basic details like name, date of birth, gender, father's name and category. The general and OBC category candidates will have to submit proof of payment of fee of Rs. 2000/-.

Step-2: Document Verification

The candidate will proceed to verification of documents. The documents uploaded by the candidate at the time of online application will be verified with originals produced by the candidate. If all the documents required as per TCIL advertisement is submitted and verified with originals, the candidate will proceed for skill test. Otherwise, he/she will be disqualified.

Step-3: Skill Test

After successful verification of documents, the candidate will proceed to skill test. The panel of doctors will carry out the skill test of the candidate. After successful skill test, the candidate will come out of the venue.

DOs and DON'Ts for Candidates

1. Candidates are advised to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to their scheduled time to avoid last minute rush.
2. The candidates are allowed to carry documents only. They are advised not to carry mobiles, laptops, bags etc. within the venue/school premises. They must keep such things outside.
3. The candidates are advised to maintain a professional demeanour and respect the privacy of others during the process.
